*AU Gold Animal designates an animal produced solely from descendants of embryos or semen from Australia. Animal must display exceptional breed type to include, but not limited to carcass shape, black points, fully haired, and complete shed pattern. Board to approve through pictures or inspection, must submit board approval form (provided by the board) with registration application for AU Gold Animal.

Directions for Registry Application:

- a. Black points, eyes, feet, etc., good shedding pattern, fully shed by 14 months of age, full hair coat, never been shorn, no scurs, body shape as defined by breed standards
- b. Sire must have nothing further than grandsire of Australian genetics (example: Embryo ram used, this candidate for AU Gold is out of an offspring from that embryo ram). This is to keep our genetics moving forward and up-to-date with Australia.
- c. Cannot be out of multi-sire program, after F3 (known lineage is a must as stated in breed up documents).
- d. Dam must be F6 or direct lineage of ET .
- e. Pictures/video submitted to board or committee, or on farm review of animals to ensure they meet criteria. This is to ensure an elite phenotypical animal.
